A Brief Reflection

Programs

In the last two years NRNA NCC NL prepared yearly agenda of the tentative events and as being the common platform we have tried to coordinate among the Nepali organizations to develop the mutual support and harmony . In most of the Programs NRNA NCC NL was the co-sponsor , partner organizer.

1. Interaction with High level Nepali Delegates in the Netherlands:

NRNA NCC NL organized an interaction programme with Hon. Finance Minister of Nepal Mr. Shankar Koirala and NRNA President Candidate Mr. Shesh Ghale in the city of Den Haag in September 17, 2013.

2. Global Conference 2013 in Kathmandu :

It was a huge number and effective participation from the Netherlands in the global conference of NRNA in Kathmandu. ICC Sharada Baraily , ICC Elect Mr. Fanindra Panta , President Krishnaraj Adhikari, VP Himal Gurung, Ex Com Member Dinesh Kharel , Advisor Prem Singh Gurung, Puspa Baruwal , Sashi Paudel , Surendra Bam , Prem Gurung , Karma Gurung and other members from the Netherlands were in the deligate team . ICC Elect, Mr Fanindra Panta has presented the report from the Netherlands in the international conference of 66 other National Councils of NRNA. In the same conference NRNA has made some constitutional amendments, Nepal Governments registered NRNA , A new International coordination Council was elected in the Presidency of Mr. Shesh Ghale . The Presidents of Nepal , Prime Minister, Home and Foreign Ministers , all the top leaders of political Parties addressed and congratulated NRNA and NRN's all over the world.

3. Women's Festival TEEJ 2013/2014 :

This program was organized in Amsterdam by NRNA NCC NL in September 2013 . Whereas in the year 2014, Teej program is organized by Nepal Music Foundation in Association with NRNA NCC NL.

NRNA NCC NL has always offered cordial help to many Nepali organizations in the Netherlands and we tried to develop mutual understanding to promote activities of all the Nepali organizations in Nepali society in the Netherlands.

4. Dashain 2013/2014 :

On the auspicious occasion of **Dashain** in October 14, 2013 , NRNA NCC NL organized a mega event in collaboration with all the Nepalese organizations in the Netherlands . It was the first successful effort where all the organizations came together to celebrate Nepal's National Festival Dashain. It was a milestone event to maintain the unity and social harmony within the Nepalese people in the Netherlands. Likewise "Bada Dashain" 2014 was also organized together in the Netherlands on the 3rd of October 2014.

5. Cultural Programme organized by IAF :

NRNA NCC NL, sponsored the **cultural programme** organized by **IAF** in Utrecht with singers Mr. Deepak Bajracharya and artist Jharana thapa in December 18, 2013.

6. Open Interaction Program with NRN NCC NL Members :

This open interaction program was held in the official presence of NRNA European Regional Coordinator and Deputy Coordinators, respectively, Mr. **Arjun K. Shrestha**, and Mr. **Som Sapkota**.

7. Nepali Film Fare Award and Second European Dance Competition :

NRNA NCC NL sponsored the first ever **Nepali Film Fare Award and Second European Dance Competition** as a Joint organiser, organised by **INAS Central Committee**, in Hoofddorp on 29-30 march 2014.

8. Interaction with NRNA ICC President Shesh Ghale in June 2014

9. The NRNA European Regional meeting held in Barcelona , Spain on June 7-8, 2014.

NRNA NCC NL had sponsored euro 500 . ICC Representative Mr. Fanindra Panta , President Mr. Krishnaraj Adhikari , VP. Prem Kaji Gurung , NRNA Advisor Sashi Paudyal, Formar President Harry Paudel and Committee Member of NRNA ICC task Force for Culture, Heritage and Literature Mr. Puspa Baruwal had participated from the Netherlands. Our delegate team took part on various discussions and charity programs to **enhance more regional cooperation and solidarity**. The ERM Spain was a huge success for NRN 's and the Nepalese people altogether.

10. The Nepali new year 2071/2072 :

Likewise the previous year “The Nepali new year”2072 was co-sponsored by the NRNA NCC NL along with the “Moj Gar Team” the organizers with the same motive of promoting Nepali organizations in the Netherlands for the harmonious brotherhood and unity.

11. Nepal weekend ; Picnic 2014

NRNA NCC NL has supported Nepal Samaj Netherlands to organize the yearly Nepal Weekend and Picnic 2014. The program was special with the participation of Nepal embassy Brussels . Football tournaments among the Four Nepali Youth Football team was the main attraction of this event.

12. BBQ EVENT to remark 10 years NRNA NCC NL in July 19 2015 :

On the occasion of the 10 years of its establishment. The NRNA NCC NL organized a BBQ program in Amsterdam.

Women Forum formation & Activities

International women’s day 2014 & 2015:

To remark **International women’s day** NRNA NCC NL organized a rally on march 8 in Amsterdam . On the same day we have formed NRNA Women’s Forum Netherlands. To address the problems within the women and to set the leadership development, NRNA NCC NL has always committed to help the women forum and help women in social activities for their welfare.

Youth Forum & Activities

To address the feeling of our young generation in the Netherlands , NRNA NCC NL is committed to develop and further enhance each and every community and sector. We have committed a sponsorship to the Nepali Football Team - Netherlands. NRNA NCC NL has provided 550 euro sponsorship to The Nepal Team in World Cup Netherlands and 200 euro sponsorship to the Nepal Team in Tournament in Belgium with other Nepal Team Belgium. Likewise NRNA NCC NL sponsored the NRNA Football team to take part in the First European NRNA challenge football tournament in Aarau Switzerland. With the love and support of Nepalese in the Netherlands we claimed the second position in the Finals. The Second European Football tournament will be hosted by NRNA NCC NL in 2016 in the Netherlands. This way, we are supporting the sportive youth to promote themselves among international youths and tie-up the relation among Nepalese youth in Europe. This is a long term plan. We appeal your support.

Cooperation with Nepal Embassy to facilitate Nepal Government service to NRNs in the Netherlands in 2014/2015

1. Passport and Documents from Nepal Government.

NRNA NCC NL assisted the Embassy of Nepal to facilitate the passport distribution program and in the collection of forms for new applicants in 2014. Working together with the Govt. of Nepal to facilitate NRNs in the Netherlands is our top priority. As per the direction of The Government of Nepal and Embassy of Nepal, Benelux in 2015. NRNA NCC NL organized a venue along with the Consular's General office Netherlands and Embassy of Nepal Benelux to collect all the application for the renewal of the Nepali passport to those friends who had difficulties to go to Belgium. We have also managed collectively to brought them from Belgium to the Netherlands to avoid unnecessary expenses of our Nepali community.

2. Placement of Buddha Statue in the City of Delft, The Netherlands

NRNA NCC NL has placed the statue of Buddha in Cooperation with Nepal Embassy and Nepal Samaj Netherlands in the premises of World Art Delft , Delft Municipality the Netherlands.

3. Interaction in the Draft Constitution of Nepal

As per the request of the Nepal government on the constitution writing process, NRNA NCC NL organized an interaction among the NRNs in the Netherlands to advice in the Draft of the constitution prepared by Constitution Assembly . The collective voice from NRNs in the Netherlands has been sent to the Nepal government through Embassy and NRNA Secretariat .

Charity Programs in the Netherlands

"Paropakari Kos"

NRNA NCC NL President Mr. Krishna Raj Adhikary in the Dashain Festival announced the establishment of **"Paropakari Kos" in the Netherlands for social charity to support the difficulties of Nepalese living in the Netherlands and to support in the urgency in humanitarian support** . The Executive Committee helped with 200 euro financial support to Mr. Basanta Raj Lamichane in the accident in Amsterdam, setting an example of responsibility to the needy people within our community.

Sustainable & Innovative Project Development in the initiatives of NRN Professionals

For the involvement of professionals of various sector in the NRNA movements , NRNA NCC NL formed a new committee for **high skilled professionals** within the Netherlands as committee for

international affairs **CIA** in the co-ordination of ICC Representative Fanindra Panta. In their initiatives NCC NL organized an interaction programme(Innovative solutions) in Hoofddorp in February 15, 2014. Likewise , in April 5 2014 a follow up interaction has been conducted in the university of Delft, Science Center in the presence of His Excellency the Ambassador of Nepal Ram Mani Pokharel and many dignitaries and professionals . Five project groups has been formed in the sector of 1. IT and Information System Development 2. Water Resource and Sediment knowledge Center 3. Skill & Knowledge transfer in Health Sector 4. Charity in Education & Health ; Aviyan Nepal NRN Chapter. 5. Business Promotion & Entrepreneurship Development .

At this stage, Group 2. Experts in Water Resource has developed a concept and preparing to implement a pilot project “ Operation of Situation Room” from the Delft to support the Prevention and Management in Natural Disaster in Nepal . Group 3 has been developed network and established cooperation between Sanquin Consulting Service of the Sanquin Blood Bank Amsterdam and Central Blood Transfusion Laboratory , Kathmandu. System Upgrade for Safe and sustainable Blood Transfusion Service in Nepal is the motto of this group in the first step . Group 4 . has been conducted a pilot project in Birtamod Eye Hospital . Group 5 has also established a cooperative concept in developing business model for crowd funding and mutual cooperation among Nepali entrepreneurs of the similar interest groups .

Financial Transparency

For the **financial transparency**, we have formally announced the formation of External Audit Committee and the committee was given responsibility to audit all the financial transactions of last four years and submit the report to the current Executive Committee . The NRNA NCC NL EX COM decided to settle all the financial issues and move forward to work more for the community once the audit report was submitted. The team has conducted their work on stipulated time which was submitted to NRNA NCC NL in January 2015. The report is published by the Ex Com in February 2015 .

Organizational Transparency and information Update

For the better web communication , the NRNA NCC NL website has been revised and updated . Data collection of general members and Nepalese diaspora will continue all the term 2013-2015, followed by the transparency of the progress report and financial report to be posted in every six months in the website for all the general members.

NCC contribution to ICC and Donations in Nepal in 2013- 2015

In the past two years, the NRNA NC NL team has paid more attention to support NRNA ICC initiatives in institutional manner and to provide supports to some pilot projects in Nepal which are initiated by NRN members of the Netherlands .

1. NCC Membership Contribution to ICC

In the year 2013-2015 , NCC NL has transferred euro 900 as the membership contribution to the ICC in the Global Conference 2013.

2. “Hariyo Ban Nepal ko dhan” :

NRNA NCC NL funded The project “Hariyo Ban Nepal ko dhan” by Sewak Thapa , volunteers and friends of Nepal .The motive of planting trees in Nepal was an outstanding idea to preserve Nepal’s greenery and environment. The project is launched in few VDC ‘s in Nepal by now and is looking for more sponsorship to give the maximum output.

3. World Cyclist from Nepal :

The group of reverse cyclists from Nepal, Mr. Biresh Dahal, Mr. Barun Raj Adhikari and Mr. Bajendra Mahara reached the Netherlands in July 2014 , Likewise the other world tour cyclist from Nepal MR. Lok bandu karki wason reached the Netherlands in July 2014 too . Their world tour programme were facilitated with accommodation , food and hi tech gadgets along with some financial support. We have also organised an interaction with them in Amsterdam and Den Haag respectively. Our respect for their humble ambition **to promote Nepal.**

4. Help in Natural Disaster in Nepal ; sunkoshi floods

The flood victims by **sunkoshi** river in Sindupalchowk district were supported by the immediate transfer of amount euro 850, (eight hundred and fifty) as per the decision by the Ex-Com.

5. Supporting Education in Mountain Region of Nepal :

Supporting Education in Mountain Region of Nepal , a projects of Dutch Mountain Trekkers and Nepali Students of IN Holland University is supported by NRNA NCC with 300 euro financial Support.

6. The Uterus Prolepses project for those women in Nepal

The Uterus Prolepses project for those women in Nepal whom are financially unable to go through the surgery , proposed by the NRNA ICC was been funded the amount of euro 1300 as our contribution from the NRNA NCC NL.

7. The NRNA headquarters building project :

NRNA NCC NL has contributed Euro 2700 , for the first phase to The NRNA headquarters building project Proposed by the NRNA ICC . The second phase of our contribution was somehow obstructed by the devastating earthquake in Nepal but we are still committed to contribute more money in near future. The total amount committed by the NRNA NCC NL was Nrs. 10 lakhs. “ **EK se Ek Nepali Facebook Scheme**” was successful to raise the fund in this concern . More than 100 of NRNS from the Netherlands has committed to contribute for this noble cause !

8. Sankhamul Bagmati Garden Project :

As the partner of ICC initiatives , NCC the Netherlands has also committed to plant one tree by contributing one Laks Nepali Rupees . Moreover our Founder President and NRNA ICC Advisor Sashi K Paudyal has supported the project by providing one Laks rupees .

9. One NRN Family Sponsor one Child for Schooling

Giving continuity to the charity work of previous EX-Com NRNA NCC NL we have been providing the charity fund to the V.D.R.C, a local partner organization in Nepal working in the welfare of needy children to support their education. We are already sponsoring 22 children and we are furthermore committed to run this project in long term.

10. Health Project ; Gift for Sight

NRNA NCC NL is always committed to help the poor and needy people in Nepal. The ABHIYAN NEPAL NRN Group in Netherlands who launching the eye operation project in association with Birtamode Eye Hospital Jhapa is supported by NRNA NCC NL. In the first model phase of the project 250 euro collected by Aviyen Nepal NRN Group and 250 euro (50%) funding by NRNA EX COM, a total amount of 500 euro is transferred by NRNA NCC NL for the implementation via NRNA Charity fund of Central Secretariat Kathmandu. We have expected to provide eye lenses to 50 eye patients as per the motto NRNA NCC NL has helped 50 blind people to get eye lenses after operation of their eyes and help them to see the world again ! This is a long term project.

11. Earthquake : Rescue , Relief & Rebuild

As we all know that our motherland was hit by a massive earthquake and took almost 9 thousand lives and injured many more Nepali and left them without shelter. NRNA NCC NL took it as a responsibility to help in this devastating situation by collecting funds and also directly helping NRNA by sending volunteers in the coordination of our ICC Representative Fanindra Panta . The collective sum of money contributed by various Nepali organizations in Netherlands is more than 40 thousand euro where as NRNA NCC NL has contributed more than NRs 10 lakhs itself to the NRNA earthquake relief fund, in Kathmandu.

NRNA NCC NL took the initiation to establish the mechanism to work collectively with various organizations in the Netherlands along with the Consular General's office and we have formed a new team of Dutch Nepal United to gather fund and resources' to contribute for the rehabilitation

program to the earthquake victims in Nepal. We are still in procedure of collecting funds to help our motherland in any way. With the Dutch Nepal United , the vigil (lighting candles) in memory to the earthquake victims was organized in Amsterdam. In future the charity dinner will be organized to collect fund.

To support in the reconstruction of Nepal shall be the Top Priority of upcoming Executive Committee to Support the NRNA ICC Rebuild Nepal Mission !
